Scripture uses the rock to portray different symbols.

rock" (Matthew 7:24). The rock was also a source of provision. Paul highlights this when he wrote, "For they drank of that spiritual rock" (1 Corinthians 10 :4). 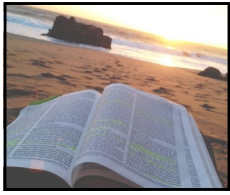
